Fr. Ludger Grun will visit St. Peter's from Saturday November 10th until Thursday November 15th and will preach a Parish mission. This is what he writes.....

### ***Parish Mission on the Sacrament of Marriage***

*Married people have to face many challenges, from inside and outside. This can be an exhausting task, and spouses seem to share the same fate as one married woman who put it like this: "The first few years of my marriage were happy, and now we have to pull through until death!" But is this the will of God? A look at the wedding of Cana promises another perspective. Many Catholic couples strive to do their best by praying, going to Mass, saying the Rosary, and raising their children in a Catholic way. But what about relying and building upon the sacrament of marriage? For most people this is an unknown territory. They leave aside a wealth of strength and new life for their relationship, because they don't know how to use it. The parish*

*mission on marriage helps us to discover the will of God, which is to see marriages and families flourish through the help of this beautiful sacrament. Experience from other Parish missions shows that these 5 days of conferences can lead to a true and encouraging transformation of marriages. Monday through Friday there will be a Mass with sermon at 11am for mothers and at 7pm, there will be rosary and conference (one hour long). The sermon in the morning and the conference at 7pm will have the same topic. This way, mothers can come in the morning and fathers in the evening and both have the opportunity to hear the same material. Please, reserve this week for your family!*

This is a wonderful grace for married couples and young people considering marriage although it will not be suitable for children and younger adolescents.
